#### 6. New Business

Lori calculated potential profits of doing a photo booth using disposable cameras, or with a professional photographer. May look into doing a photo booth next school year.

Request for funding for an end of year school trip for the grade 3 students to visit Middleville Museum. Council voted unanimously to provide \$200 towards the cost. School will fund the additional cost of \$311 for the transportation.

Request for funding for an end of year school trip for the grade 6 students to visit YMCA-YWCA Bonnenfant outdoor education and leadership centre on June 14, 2023. Council voted unanimously to provide \$250 towards the total cost of \$1927.78. School will cover an additional cost of \$400 towards transportation. Grade 6 families will be required to pay approx. \$30 per student to attend event.

### 7. Principal's Report – Wilson Parks

Report cards went out on February 16<sup>th</sup>. Kinder report cards were redistributed as the school year was misprinted.

Staff are busy with term 2 IEP's.

Timetables for next year in planning has begun and will continue until end of the year.

Projected 317 students for next year. Hopeful staff allotment will remain the same for next year.

Enrolment for 23/24 kindergarten is currently at 37 students.

Possible collaboration with CPHS for a shared art/music room at Caldwell.
